Learned counsel for the Trust has made available for the perusal of the Court, the bye-law relating to the terms of employment and working conditions of the employee of the Shri Mahamaya Balasundari Jee Trilokpur Temple Trust, which stands framed in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the H.P. Hindu Public Religious Institution and Charitable Endowment Act, 1984 and has further informed the Court that part-V of the same stood amended in the year 2018 by following the due process in terms whereof the age of superannuation with regard to Class-III employee stood amended to 58 years. He further submits that after the incorporation of the said amendment, all Class-III employees were retired at the age of 58 years and the amendment is well within the knowledge of the petitioner. He further submits that other amendments were also incorporated in the year 2018 and the petitioner has availed all the benefits thereof, but he is

showing ignorance to amendment to the age of superannuation.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be granted some time to have instructions in the matter.
